Proposals

- Step forward a common ITG Economics research theme - Globalisation, Development, Inequality: Lessons from the BRICS.
NB: there are still three open spots for the issue on Inequality! Stimulate colleagues.
- To follow up with research seminars in BRICS meeting hosting like those organised previously at the Cape Town University and Campinas University in 2018 and 2019.
- Encourage participation in national/university conferences through special sessions related to the BRICS research agenda i.e. Migration Conference in MGIMO in December 2019 and April Conference in HSE in April 2020.
- Explore wider mechanisms for the inclusion of non-member Universities into the abovementioned ITG research programme without becoming formal members of NU BRICS.
- Facilitate mobility of students within BRICS NU through signing the multilateral student exchange agreement.
- To encourage joint organisation of visiting professors lectures in order to promote BRICS NU among students and professors of all ITG's members in hosting country.
- During the Russian presidency in 2020 to organise second Winter/Summer School and make it thematic (in correspondence with special issue topic: Globalization, Development, Inequality).
- During the Russian presidency in 2020 to organise ITG Meeting in the framework of the BRICS NU Annual Conference.
- To put all the materials of the 1st BRICS NU Winter School in University of Campinas on the website of ITG in Economics.






